Distinguished Lecture by Professor Dan Lasserson-"Hospital at Home – the future of healthcare?"

In this lecture, Prof Dan Lasserson described the concept of, and evidence for, delivering acute medical care in the place that patients call home. Prof Lasserson runs an acute hospital at home service from the Geriatric Medicine department at the John Radcliffe Hospital in Oxford and is a Past President of the UK Hospital at Home Society. With advances in diagnostic and monitoring technology, more patients could be assessed and treated without any conveyance to hospital if that is their choice. Drawing on his recent research based at Warwick University Medical School and presentation of clinical cases he has managed, we will see how patients with higher acuity medical problems and complexity can be given a care pathway that is personalised as well as delivering key processes of healthcare at home.
