Representing Ireland and the Department of Health - Ireland at the European Health and Innovation Summit in Warsaw

Prof. Markus Helfert and Denise Manton had the pleasure of representing Ireland and the Department of Health - Ireland at the European Health and Innovation Summit and the TEHDAS2 joint action General Assembly in Warsaw this month.

TEHDAS2 (co-funded by the European Commission) is paving the way for the harmonised implementation of the secondary use of health data in the European Health Data Space (EHDS). Ireland is actively contributing to several TEHDAS2 work packages, and it was inspiring to engage with European colleagues on this important initiative.

The discussions in Warsaw reinforced that EHDS is not just about innovation—it's about trust, governance, and empowering citizens. As we move towards implementation, strong data governance will be essential to ensure transparency, security, and ethical use of health data. Over the next four years, collaboration between governments, researchers, healthcare providers, industry and citizens will be key to ensuring EHDS delivers on its promise—transforming healthcare while safeguarding fundamental rights.



EnTrust Doctoral Network T4 Training week at Maynooth University

The EnTrust Doctoral Network is a doctoral network dedicated to training Doctoral Candidates as a new generation of "Data Executives" who promote fair, transparent, and trusted data sharing in agriculture.

ENTRUST regularly organizes thematic training weeks for its doctoral researchers, combining seminars, workshops, and networking opportunities. As part of this mission, EnTrust doctoral candidates at Maynooth University organized the T4 Training Week, bringing together experts in data governance, data sovereignty, interoperability, and cybersecurity to foster collaboration and innovative thinking.



During the T4 Training Week (24th to 28th February 2025), participants enjoyed a variety of thought-provoking presentations. **Ville Sirviö** from NIIS kicked off with an exploration of the future of digital public infrastructure, stressing the importance of secure, interoperable systems for cross-border services. **Anil Turkmayali** from International Data Spaces followed with insights on interoperability and data sovereignty in agriculture, examining how trusted data exchanges can boost innovation in the sector. **Ruth Buckley** of Cork City Council rounded off the day with discussions on cybersecurity and data protection in local government, highlighting strategies to safeguard citizens' data. In addition to these, the

program covered a wide scope of themes, such as the relationship between open geospatial data and data quality by **Peter Mooney** from Maynooth University, and how earth observation data informs agricultural policy, presented by **Stuart Green** from Teagasc.

The week also featured a Design Science Research panel session, which offered researchers an opportunity to explore best practices in research methodologies. With interactive workshops and site visits, the event seamlessly connected theory with real-world practices, enabling all participants to explore new solutions for the rapidly evolving world of digital infrastructure and data sharing in agriculture.

Local Government CORE (LG-CORE) Project

The Local Government CORE (LG-CORE) is a dedicated Information Sharing and Analysis Centre (ISAC) for Ireland's 31 local authorities, established to enhance cybersecurity resilience through collaboration, threat intelligence sharing, and strategic capability development. Built on the Dutch ISAC Development Model, LG-CORE provides a structured framework for sector-wide information sharing, capability development, and proactive cybersecurity measures. This model focuses on five key competencies—Strategy and Action Plan, Working Methods, Information Management, Situational Awareness, and Action—each with three maturity levels, enabling a progressive improvement in cybersecurity readiness.

The Innovation Value Institute (IVI) has been a key partner in LG-CORE's development since 2022, bringing its expertise in IT capability maturity assessment and digital transformation to support the initiative. This year, IVI in collaboration with the National Cyber Security Centre (NCSC), is developing a Sectoral Capability Assessment to establish a cybersecurity maturity baseline for local authorities. This assessment will leverage IVI's IT Capability Maturity Framework (IT-CMF) alongside NCSC's Risk Management Measures, providing each local authority with a personalized report benchmarking their cybersecurity capabilities against sectoral benchmarks. This initiative will offer a clear roadmap for cybersecurity enhancement, supporting local authorities in meeting emerging regulatory requirements, including the EU NIS2 Directive. By systematically assessing and improving sectoral capabilities, LG-CORE is laying the groundwork for a more resilient public sector, equipped to tackle the complex cybersecurity challenges of the digital era.

Prof. Markus Helfert Visit Zeppelin University - Germany

Prof. Markus Helfert visited the [The Open Government Institute | TOGI](#) at the Zeppelin University in Germany on 17th of February. Part of the visit was a workshop to exchange new research results related to Smart Cities, Artificial Intelligence and Citizen Participation. Prof. Helfert discussed the [Data Governance programme](#) he is leading at the Innovation Value Institute and some of the research projects at IVI.



In the afternoon Professor Dr Vaz, Prof. of Public Policy Management at the University of São Paulo and Prof. Jorge Machado, University of São Paulo shared their work on Smart Cities, AI and citizen participation with a particular focus on public administration. The event was hosted and chaired by Prof. Dr. Jörn von Lucke, Chair of Public Administration and Information Systems at the Zeppelin University and the Director of The Open Government Institute (TOGI).
